

Aztec secures large AV contract

Aztec Event Services has been appointed as an “audio visual partner” by international super event WorldSkills, for its London début in October 2011 at ExCeL London.

Often referred to as the Skills Olympics, WorldSkills is an international competition of practical skills and will be one of 2011’s largest events in the UK. It will take up the entirety of ExCeL London where over 150,000 expected visitors will see 1,000 competitors from 50 countries/regions competing in 45 skill areas over four exciting days of competition.
